

CASH FLOW

- **REVIEW**: Financial Statements (3 Parts)
 - Income Statement = how much the Company made or lost in accounting profits during yr/quarter
 - Cash Flow Statement = define next
 - <u>Balance Sheet</u> = how much the Company owns (assets) & what the Company owes (liabilities) at a specific time. (How strong is the business)

Cash Flow

- Simple definition = it is the cash that flows in & out of the Company
- Indicates how much cash a company makes year to year

Cash Flow

- Three parts to CASH FLOW:
- Cash from Operating Activities
- Cash from Investing Activities
- Cash from Financing

CASH FLOW

- Cash from <u>Operating Activities</u> =
 Cash the business generates &/or spends
 - -Positive cash flow
 - -Negative cash flow
 - -Compare Cash Flow Number to the Earnings Number

Cash Flow

- Cash from <u>Investing Activities</u> =
 Money used to buy or sell assets
 & investments
 - -Property, Plants & Equipment
 - -Invest in stocks &/or bonds

Cash Flow

 Cash from <u>Financing</u> = Cash from outside sources: borrowed from banks or investors or capital raised by issuing more shares

Importance of Cash Flow Statement

- Multiple Valuations vs Cash Flow Valuation
- <u>Free cash flow</u> = amount of money that can be taken out of the business each year without harming its ability to continue to do business!

CASH FLOW

 The trail of cash flow as stated before begins with the Net Income value (from the Income Statement) and ends with the Balance shown on the Balance statement.
